MISSION GRANTS

In response to Jesus' Great Commission, the LWML supports various mission grants each biennium. The grants are chosen by the delegates at convention and funded with mites that were gathered during the previous biennium.

Contributions are collected regularly and sent to the Indiana District LWML Financial Secretary. All districts retain 75% of the mite offerings to fund district mission grants and 25% is sent to the LWML to fund national mission grants.
