

RUTH ARMEL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES FOR THE INDIANA DISTRICT LWML CONVENTION

PURPOSE OF SCHOLARSHIP

The Purpose of the Ruth Armel Scholarship is to strengthen the LWML in congregations by sending women who are active in their congregations, but cannot meet the expense of attending District Convention. This scholarship aims to strengthen particularly the involvement of minority women, young mothers, single mothers, and young women.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Has not previously attended an LWML District or National Convention in 10 yrs.
2. Is involved in local congregation with some activity connected to the LWML.
3. Attends church and communion regularly.
4. Will not attend as a delegate to the Convention.
5. The expense of the Convention is not within the financial resources of the family.

WHAT IS COVERED

1. The District pays registration, meal package, housing and entertainment connected with the Convention.
2. Room charges are based on 4 per room, but 2 per room is allowed if necessary.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED

1. Cost of transportation and any other needs not outlined above.
2. Applicant is responsible for securing her own transportation.
3. Side tours.

NOTE: NO PAYMENT WILL BE MADE DIRECTLY TO THE APPLICANT

HOW TO APPLY:

1. Fill out the application, including the Pastor's portion.
2. Include a letter from your LWML Society President which states why she believes you will enhance your society by attending this Convention.

The deadline is May 1, 2018. The District Ruth Armel Committee will select scholarship recipients and notify them. There may be multiple recipients.
